

A Subject You Now Like

Describe a subject that you once were not very interested in but are now interested in.

or

Describe a subject that you once thought was not very interesting but now think is interesting.

You should say:

what subject it is

how long you studied it

why you thought it was not interesting

and explain why you now find it to be interesting.

Note

- A few people have reported this as, "Describe a subject that you didn't like before but now like." However, most people report it using the word, "interesting" or "interested in".

Part 3

Students

- What subjects do most students in your country study at school?
- Do you think it's better for high school students to study many subjects or to specialize in just a few subjects?

- Which subjects would you say everyone should (or, needs to) study?
- Can you suggest why some school students learn more than others?
- How can a student master the subject they are studying?

- Do you think communication skills need to be learned?

Teachers

- What would you say is the main job, or task of being a teacher?
- Do you think teachers should guide the students?
- Do you think a teacher needs to be interested in what they are teaching?
- (Different to above) Do you think a teacher needs to be interested in teaching?
- What would the result if a teacher was (were) bored?

The Internet as a Source of Knowledge

- Do you think using the internet is a good way to increase one's knowledge?
- What sorts of information can be found on the internet?
- Is it easy to search for information on the internet?
- Do you think playing games on the internet teaches people anything?
